Fire Officer I

Fire Officer I is conducted on line through Target Solutions. The class runs for 3 weeks and includes 2 periodic exams, 1 final exam, 6 TCFP state skills tests, and 1 TCFP state proctored exam. All of the exams and skills evaluations will take place at the El Paso Fire Department Training Academy unless otherwise announced.

Scheduled Classes:

October 10, 2016 through October 28, 2016

Prerequisites: Basic Structural Fire Protection, Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting, or Marine Fire Protection and Fire Service Instructor I certification.

Requirements: Complete a Fire Officer I training program and pass the certification exam.

A commission-approved* Fire Officer I training program consists of:

- Completion of the Fire Officer I curriculum as specified in file Chapter
 9 of the commission's Certification Curriculum Manual: or
- Completion of an out-of-state, NFA, or military training program which has been submitted to the commission and which meets the minimum requirements; or
- Completion of the college courses listed in TAC §451.3(B)(iii).

Fire Instructor I

Fire Instructor I is conducted on line through Target Solutions. The class runs for 2 weeks and includes 1 periodic exam, 1 final exam, 6 TCFP state skills tests, and 1 TCFP state proctored exam. All of the exams and skills evaluations will take place at the El Paso Fire Department Training Academy unless otherwise announced.

Scheduled Classes:

October 31, 2016 through November 11, 2016

Prerequisite/Years of Experience: You must have a minimum of **three years** of experience in fire protection in a paid, volunteer, or regulated nongovernmental fire department; or in a department of a state agency, education institution or political subdivision that provides fire protection training.

Requirements: Complete a commission-approved* Fire Service Instructor I training program as outlined in Chapter 8 of the commission's Certification Curriculum Manual, and pass the certification exam.

You may also qualify for the certification exam if you can document that you have:

- A bachelor's degree or higher in education,
- A teaching certificate issued by the Texas State Board of Education, or
- An associate's degree with 12 semester hours of education instructional courses.

Fire Officer II

Fire Officer II is conducted on line through Target Solutions. The class runs for 3 weeks and includes 2 periodic exams, 1 final exam, 6 TCFP state skills tests, and 1 TCFP state proctored exam. All of the exams and skills evaluations will take place at the El Paso Fire Department Training Academy unless otherwise announced.

Scheduled Classes:

November 28, 2016 through December 16, 2016

Prerequisites: Basic Structural Fire Protection, Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting, or Marine Fire Protection Personnel, Fire Service Instructor I and Fire Officer I certification.
